

**GENERAL POLICY ON THE COMPANY'S APPROACH TO ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990**

At Stave-Con Limited we recognise the fundamental importance of environmental issues and are therefore committed to reducing the environmental impacts of our activities by preventing pollution and preserving and protecting the environment.

The environmental impacts of our operation will be considered at the earliest opportunity and an assessment carried out to detail potential environmental risks. As a result of this assessment all necessary controls will be implemented ensuring, as a minimum, that legal requirements are met.

Our commitment to the environment will be effectively communicated to employees, sub-contractors and suppliers when carrying out activities that have potential environmental consequences.

Prior to commencing work on sites controlled by other contractors Stave-Con Limited will make reasonable effort to ensure employees are aware of any potential environmental issues and adhere to the site rules.

Our commitment to environmental protection is ongoing and we aim to make continuous improvements as our organisation develops. In order to achieve this our policy will be reviewed annually.

**WASTE DISPOSAL:-**

The majority of the waste which we create is bulk hardcore, broken concrete, subsoil and topsoil together with small quantities of general builders rubbish.

**RE-CYCLING:-**

Materials will be recycled / re-used wherever possible.

**CFC's**

Our suppliers are notified of our policy of non-use of CFC's. Marking-out paint spray cans, etc., are energised by E.F.P. substitutes. Whilst our use of aerosol products is very limited we have not found any difficulty in this regard.

The stringent Health and safety and COSHH Regulations applicable to our industry comprehensively cover our employees involvement with any hazardous materials.
